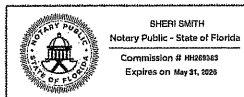

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
CONCERNING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STORM WATER MANAGEMENT OF THE TOWN OF LOWELL, INDIANA

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Department of Storm Water Management of the Storm Water District of the Town of Lowell, Indiana (the "Board") will hold a public hearing at 5:00 p.m. on May 8, 2025, at the Town Hall, located at 501 E. Main Street, Lowell, Indiana, on the matter of appropriating funds to (1) pay for the acquisition, construction, rebuilding, repair, extension and improvement of certain storm water facilities within the Storm Water District of the Town of Lowell, Indiana (the "District"), consisting of all or any portion of (a) the reconstruction of the District's existing EQ Basin including construction, construction administration, inspection and testing, (b) the reconstruction and rehabilitation of various roadways related and/or physically connected to the storm water collection and disposal system of the District, and (c) other miscellaneous improvements to the storm water collection and disposal system of the District (clauses (a) through and including (c), collectively the "Project"), (2) fund a reserve fund (if necessary), (3) pay capitalized interest (if necessary) on the bonds of the District, in one or more series, to finance the Project (the "Bonds"), and (4) pay all or any portion of the costs and expenses incurred on account of or in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, including any fees for bond insurance or other credit enhancement with respect to the Bonds. Such appropriation will be provided from the proceeds of the Bonds in an amount not to exceed Six Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$6,250,000), together with all interest earnings thereon.

Said appropriation is in addition to any appropriations provided for in the existing budget and tax levy. At said public hearing, all persons shall have the right to appear and be heard on the necessity of said appropriation.
