Core 4 Properties Facade Grant - 2021 - Tom Salkovski - 1504 N. Main Street, Crown Point, IN Mr. Salkovski stated they would like to request an additional \$10,000.00 for both last year and this year; stating he has over \$65,000.00 in receipts for a remodel to the building along Commercial Avenue and Clark Street, including new windows, tuckpointing, and brick. Mr. Hendrix stated last year the request was for \$20,000.00 and the Town Council approved \$10,000; stating he could come back for additional money, however all the facade grant money had been given out for 2020. In order to ask for another \$10,000.00, it would have to be for a new project and would have to be approved. Mr. Salovski stated they still owe for windows, which will be paid in 2021. Mr. Salatas recommended he submits another application for a 2021 grant for the windows.
