SUBJECT: Reconstruction of Washington Street

As you probably know, the Lowell Town Council recently awarded street a reconstruction project for Washington Street between Liberty Street to the CSX Railroad tracks. Town and Country Construction of Demotte was awarded the project in the amount of \$639,303. Fifty percent of the costs of this project was offset by a Community Crossings Matching Grant awarded to the town by INDOT.

This project will include the complete reconstruction and replacement of the roadway pavement, subgrade, sidewalks, curbs, drive aprons and ADA Ramps. Additionally, a new ten-foot-wide pedestrian pathway with pedestrian lighting will be constructed to accommodate the extension of the Freedom Trail from Nassau Park to the downtown.

Work on this project is anticipated to begin the week of August 10, 2025. The roadway will be closed to through traffic. Local traffic will be accommodated but should expect periods of temporary closures to allow for construction of driveways and the removal and replacement of roadway pavement and drainage structures. Work is anticipated to be completed in early fall of this year. Residents should refrain from parking in the street during construction. Access to driveways will be restored at the end of each day unless excavation or the placement of infrastructure prohibits it. Residents are encouraged to share parking with neighbors or on other streets if work temporarily prohibits parking in their driveways.
