SUBJECT: Street Resurfacing

The Lowell Town Council recently awarded a street resurfacing contract to Town and Country Construction of Demotte in the amount of \$948,545.17. Fifty percent of the cost of this project is being offset by a Community Crossings Matching Grant awarded to the town by INDOT.

The following streets are included in the project:

- Crestwood from Joe Martin to Burr
- Blackwood from Crestwood to Driftwood
- Eastwood from Crestwood to Northwood
- Woodbridge from Harrison to 177th
- Tiffany Court
- Susan from 177th to Sarah
- Sarah from Susan to Brookwood

Work on this project will include the removal and replacement of roadway pavement, replacement of ADA sidewalk ramps, stormwater structure repair and removal and replacement of selected curbs and sidewalks. Areas of curb and sidewalk replacement will be selected by the project engineer and will only include sidewalks that are non-ADA compliant and curbs that no longer function to direct stormwater to the drainage systems. Sidewalks will also be installed in some areas that don't currently have a sidewalk.

Work on this project is anticipated to begin August 6, 2025. Local traffic will be accommodated but should expect periods of temporary closures to allow for construction of driveways and the removal and replacement of roadway pavement and drainage structures. Work is anticipated to be completed in early fall of this year. Residents should refrain from parking in the street during construction. Access to driveways will be restored at the end of each day unless excavation or the placement of infrastructure prohibits it. Residents are encouraged to share parking with neighbors or park on other streets if work temporarily prohibits parking in their driveways.
