Assignment:

On July 3rd, 2025, at approximately 10:53 AM, I, Officer Mink of the Lowell Police Department, was dispatched to the front lobby of the Lowell Police Department for an Animal Problem. Upon arrival, I spoke with the Complainant, Robert Kelley (Address: 13560 Kristy St, Cedar Lake, IN 46303; DOB: [REDACTED]).

Kelley Statement:

Kelley stated on July 2nd, 2025, at approximately 8:00 AM, he visited the Dog Park located at Freedom Park (Address: 17105 Cline, Lowell, IN 46356) with his dog "Finn" (A red poodle 3 years of age). Kelley stated he took Finn into the smaller dog park. Kelley stated he entered into the small holding area between the outside and inside gate of the dog run area. Kelley stated upon opened the inner gate an older looking yellow Labrador approached Finn. Kelley stated the yellow dog bit Finn on the his right rear hind leg. Kelley stated he was able to pull the yellow dog from Finn. Kelley stated the yellow dog approached a second time. Kelley stated he was able to lightly kick the yellow dog to keep it from attacking Finn a second time. Kelley stated the yellow dog from salivating.

Kelley stated after the altercation an older white male, who appeared 60-70 years of age, walked over. Kelley stated the male stated "Don't kick my dog". Kelley stated he saw the male wearing a badge for the park. Kelley stated the male had his badge covered and stated "I'm not going to tell you my name". Kelley stated he took Finn to leave. Kelley stated the male appeared worried and told him, Kelley, to stay. Kelley stated he took a picture of the license plate on a Ford Escape (Indiana Registration# 498ZXS) parked in the dog park parking lot. Kelley stated it was the only other vehicle present upon his arrival. Kelley stated he took his dog to the vet for a check up. Kelley stated they diagnosed Finn with a "weeping wound". Kelley described the diagnosis as any wound that was bleeding.

Kelley stated he reported the incident to "Cindy" at town hall. Kelley stated Cindy advised she was familiar with the male who Kelley was describing and advised he was on probation for the park from previous incidents. Kelley requested the incident be documented in case of any vet bills.

Officer Actions:

I conducted a check of the license plate provided by Kelley and observed it returned to a Bryan Fuller (Address: 1565 Heritage Court, Lowell, IN 46356; DOB: [REDACTED]). I provided Kelley with a photograph of Fuller. Kelley identified Fuller as the male with whom he spoke with at the dog park. I conducted Fuller with a phone number located in Spillman. I identified myself to a male who verbally identified himself as Fuller. I advised Fuller my reason for calling was due to a reported incident at the dog park located at Freedom Park. Fuller confirmed he owned a yellow Labrador. Fuller stated he was at the dog park on July 2nd, 2025. Fuller advised a male, Kelley, was in the leashing area of the dog park. Fuller stated when Kelley opened the dog his dog approached to play with the other dogs. Fuller stated he observed Kelley kick his, Fuller's, dog. Fuller stated he told Kelley to not kick his dog. Fuller stated Kelley

asked for his name, which he declined to give Kelley. Fuller stated Kelley told him his, Fuller's, dog attacked his. Fuller stated he did not see his dog attack Kelley's dog. Fuller stated he apologized to Kelley and told him to come back as his dog just wanted to play. Fuller stated he never yelled at or to Kelley.

I advised Fuller the incident would be documented. I advised Fuller any dispute with bills between himself and Kelley would be a civil matter. I advised Fuller the female in charge of the dog park was aware of the incident and to contact her with any further information regarding any future participation with the dog park. Fuller stated he would follow up.
