The Work Session of the Lowell Town Council was called to order on Monday, November 24, 2025, at 5:40 P.M. Members present were Todd Angerman, Michael Gruszka, Shane Tucker, Phillip Kuiper and Jill Murr, Clerk-Treasurer. 
