

What is LCSWMD?

The Lake County Solid Waste Management District ("District") was established on February 5, 1991 as a single-county district by resolution of the Lake County Commissioners, pursuant to the Indiana State Legislature's passage of House Bill 1240 which required counties to form solid waste management districts. Since then, the District has developed a comprehensive plan of education, recycling assistance and technical assistance to provide countywide programs and to provide effective and efficient integrated solid waste management for the benefit of its citizens.

- HHW from businesses, schools, or non-profit organizations.
- Asbestos
- Auto/Truck/Marine (Boat)/Back-up Batteries
- Containers larger than five gallons
- Electronics
- Explosives/Fireworks (Please contact your local Fire Department for disposal)
- Large grill propane cylinders
- Latex paint
- Medical Waste (other than medications and sharps) (NO CONTROLLED MEDICATIONS)
- Radioactive materials (smoke detectors)
- Tires
