Dear Residents of Walnut Lane, Timberwood Lane and Timber Lake Drive:

The Town of Lowell has successfully procured nearly \$1 million in state grant funds for repaving and reconstructing streets throughout the town. With additional matching funds from the Town, approximately \$1.3 million dollars of street improvements will be made this year. Your street will be reconstructed as part of these improvements.

Your street is scheduled for full pavement reconstruction. Crews from Milestone will begin milling the asphalt off your roads next Monday. After the asphalt is removed, excavation crews will be working to remove and replace the underlying stone base. New asphalt will be installed once all the stone has been replaced and you will have a beautiful new street. This work should be completed within two to three weeks. Please note that this schedule is weather dependent.

The contractor will do everything possible to ensure access to driveways during construction. However, during the excavation phase, there may be short periods of time when driveway access will be restricted. Overnight access to driveways will be maintained.

We ask for your cooperation and patience during construction. Please drive carefully and be mindful of the heavy equipment and road workers which will be onsite. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or need additional information.
