SUBJECT: Road Reconstruction

Last year the Lowell Town Council received \$1 million in Community Crossing Matching Grant Funds from INDOT for road reconstruction. The town matched the INDOT grant with approximately \$330,000 of town funds. As a result, the town will begin road reconstruction beginning the week of May 15, 2022 at the following locations:

Tomahawk from Apache to Mohawk
Arrowhead from Commanche to Shawnee
Cherokee from Mohawk to Shawnee
Shawnee from Arrowhead to Navajo
Camelot from Arthur to 175th
Driftwood from Joe Martin to Gatewood

Our contractor (Milestone Construction) will begin by removing and replacing selected curbing, sidewalks and sidewalk ramps. Not all the curbing and sidewalks will be replaced. Milestone will follow by removing and replacing all the existing asphalt pavement and stone base. The asphalt course will be removed with a large milling machine. The stone base will be removed with a large excavator. Haul trucks will be utilized to remove and deliver materials. Weather permitting, the start to finish timeframe should be approximately two weeks per project area.

During construction we ask that you do not park in the street during working hours. If curb is being replaced at your drive, you may not be able to utilize your drive until the concrete cures. Residents should expect delays and difficulty traveling these roadways during construction. For your safety and Milestone's, please travel slowly and carefully through the project areas.
