SUBJECT: Street Reconstruction:
East Street
Southwood Drive
Northview Drive
Bluebird Lane
Meadow Lane between Northview and Robin

Beginning the week of June 5th our contractor (Milestone) will be working to remove and replace selected curbs and sidewalks and reconstruct the above roadway segments. Not all curbs and sidewalks will be replaced. Only those marked by the Public Works Department with white paint.

Milestone will begin by removing and replacing selected curbs, drive aprons where curb is being replaced and sidewalks on all streets except East Street. East Street will receive new drive culverts, swales and stormwater inlets. The asphalt pavement will then be milled and removed. Excavation and replacement of the stone base will follow. Once the stone base is placed and fine graded, the asphalt will be reinstalled.

Following the reconstruction, Milestone will place topsoil and seed blanket in disturbed areas of lawn. Residents should water the disturbed areas to ensure the growth of the seed. Neither Milestone nor the town will water these areas.

Milestone will do everything possible to ensure access to driveways during construction. However, during the excavation phase, there may be periods of time when driveway access is restricted. In some cases, it may be best to leave your home prior Milestone beginning work and return after they have finished for the day. You may also consider temporarily parking vehicles on adjacent streets during construction.

The process will be completed in approximately three to four weeks, weather permitting. We ask for your cooperation and patience during construction. Please drive carefully and be mindful of the heavy equipment and the workers that will be on site. Please don't hesitate to speak with us or Milestone if you have any questions.
