Notice of Construction Activities

SUBJECT: Street Resurfacing

The Lowell Town Council recently awarded a street resurfacing contract to Milestone Contractors, L.P. of Griffith in the amount of \$660,614.10. Once again fifty percent of the cost of this project will be offset by a Community Crossings Matching Grant awarded to the town by INDOT. Lowell was one of only three communities to receive these grant funds.

The following streets are included in the project:

- Woodlad Dr from Lincoln to the end
- Woodland Ct from Woodland Dr to Woodland Dr
- Woodland Cr from Woodland Dr to the end

Work on this project will include the complete removal and replacement of roadway pavement including the stone subbase, replacement of ADA sidewalk ramps, stormwater infrastructure installation and repair, signage and sanitary sewer repair.

Our contractor anticipates beginning work the week of June 1, 2026. Local traffic will be accommodated but should expect periods of temporary closures to allow for construction of driveways and the removal and replacement of roadway pavement and drainage structures. Work is anticipated to be completed in early July of this year. Residents should refrain from parking in the street during construction. Access to driveways will be restored at the end of each day unless excavation or the placement of infrastructure prohibits it. Residents are encouraged to share parking with neighbors or park on other streets if work temporarily prohibits parking in their driveways.
